DECLARATION

I have made myself acquainted with the Regulations and understand that:

1. On approval of my application I will be required to enter into a bond for whatever amount may be considered necessary.
2. Upon registration I will be permitted to receive the goods on which rebate has been granted and that such goods must be conveyed to the premises referred in the application.
3. A store for the housing of rebated goods must be provided and such store must have provision for customs locks.
4. No goods on which rebate has been allowed may be sold or disposed of without the prior permission of the Commissioner General of Malawi Revenue Authority should such goods then be sold or disposed of to any person other than another registered manufacturer the duty immediately becomes due and payable; should they be sold or transferred to another registered manufacturer a receipt must be obtained from the receiver and handed to the Malawi Revenue Authority *within the specified time*.
5. A stock book must be kept up to date in which all receipts and disposals of rebated goods are recorded in such manner as will enable me to account readily for all such goods.
6. My books and premises are to be open at any time during working hours for inspection.
7. Until such time as I have entered into a bond and have registered, and until such time as notification of the rebate appears in the Government Gazette, I will not be eligible to receive any of the appropriate goods except by payment of the full duty.
8. Should I be unable to account satisfactorily for any goods on which rebate has been allowed I am liable for the duty on the full consignment and this must be paid on demand.
9. I may be called upon to carry out under supervision of an officer of customs at such times as the Controller may deem necessary, and manufacturing operation in which materials acquired under rebate are being used; and to pay fees at the prescribed rates for the special attendance of such officer.
