# PUBLIC NOTICE

## MANDATORY USAGE OF FACE MASKS

Following the steady increase of Covid-19 pandemic cases, as announced by the Ministry of Health, all taxpayers and clients visiting premises of the Malawi Revenue Authority (MRA) are requested to wear face masks.

Across the world, medical experts have assured the public that proper usage of face masks prevents one from contacting Covid-19 and reduces chances of spreading the virus. Therefore, it is the duty and role of every member of the public visiting MRA premises to properly wear a face mask at all times.

Failure to do so will result in the taxpayer not being served and asked to leave the MRA premises.

This mandatory usage of face masks also applies to all MRA members of staff.

Everyone is reminded that a mask alone cannot protect one from Covid-19. It must be combined with other measures including maintaining at least one-metre distance from each other, washing hands frequently and avoiding touching one's face while wearing a mask.

MRA strongly encourages members of the general public to promptly report individuals and members of staff who are not using face masks.
