The method of payment will be direct deposit to a designated project account number at Reserve Bank of Malawi. The document will be sent by physical/courier or electronic mail bidders will be responsible for shipping by courier

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 3rd February 2023 at 10.00am. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 3rd February 2023 at 10.00am.
